With the 20 day comment period ending soon, we are asking for a Public Hearing on the wetlands fill and construction project, File Number 11-05-0012-P.

Working with the adjacent landowner, Al Cash, and the Three Lakes Association (TLA), we had a meeting with Doug and Christine Davis from Dewitt Marine on Friday, September 9. We had hoped to get additional information on their overall plan (current application and future plans), as well as the current and any new storm water and boat cleaning drainage plans, since they were proposing the filling in of wetlands. Unfortunately, we were told yesterday that this would probably not be available until next Monday, at the earliest.

Requesting a Public Hearing now will give all parties involved the time to gather additional information and discuss possible alternatives, prior to the open forum of a Public Hearing.
